- Each course in the first 4 semesters of BCom is of three credits except Foundation Course.
- Two credits are allotted to Foundation Course- I, II, III and IV respectively.
- In the final two semesters i.e. 5th and 6th semesters Accountancy / Management courses shall have 4 credits rest will be of 3 credits each..



- The learner would earn 20 credit points from the core courses from each semester
- The regular course would comprise of six semesters in the span of three academic years
- The learner would hence earn 120 credit points from the core courses at the end of six semesters

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### ACADEMIC PROGRESSION

A learner passes if learner secures-

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- The CGPA (Cumulative Grade Point Average) shall be calculated on the basis of core courses only.
- If the learner earns additional credits on non-academic courses in addition to 16 credits, those credit courses are also incorporated in the mark sheet.
- For the additional 12 credits, the learner would need to enroll for and complete skill enhancement and ability enhancement programs (Innovation, Incubation & Skill Enhancement Center) in 3 years (6 semesters together)

### ACADEMIC PROGRESSION

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- ### Internal Evaluation

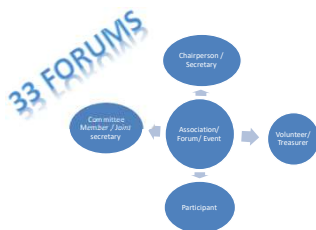
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### Re-examination for absentees
