- 4 credits of mandatory value education and Disaster management.








To earn the B Com degree

- 132 Minimum academic credits required (120 academic credits + additional 12 credits)
- 4 additional credits through **mandatory** non academic courses- (Life skill education and Disaster management)
 - 1 credit is of 30 hours of learning.







- Each course in the first 4 semesters of BCom is of three credits except Foundation Course.
- Two credits are allotted to Foundation Course-I, II, III and IV respectively.
- In the final two semesters i.e. 5th and 6th semesters Accountancy / Management courses shall have 4 credits rest will be of 3 credits each..


- The learner would earn 20 credit points from the core courses from each semester
- The regular course would comprise of six semesters in the span of three academic years
- The learner would hence earn 120 credit points from the core courses at the end of six semesters

Semester End Examination Theory Paper: Written examination Time: 2 hours Marks: 60




- The CGPA (Cumulative Grade Point Average) shall be calculated on the basis of core courses only.
- If the learner earns additional credits on nonacademic courses in addition to 16 credits, those credit courses are also incorporated in the mark sheet.
- For the additional 12 credits, the learner would need to enroll for and complete skill enhancement and ability enhancement programs (Innovation, Incubation & Skill Enhancement Center) in 3 years (6 semesters together)






Internal Evaluation

- The evaluation pattern for 40 marks for internal examination shall be decided by the respective departments and the final marks out of 40 shall be submitted to the COE in the prescribed format.
- Semester End Examination (SEE) shall be a written examination (max 60 marks) on the dates fixed by the Examination Committee. One sample question Paper set of all courses would be soon uploaded on the college website.






Re-examination for absentees

•In case learner fails in the internals then he/she shall appear for a special test of 40 marks which shall be held along with the SEE (ATKT).

•In case the learner is unable to attend the external examination, i.e. remains absent in some or all courses on medical grounds or for representing the College / University in sports, cultural activities, activities of NSS, NCC or sports training camps conducted by recognized bodies / competent authorities or for any other reason which is considered valid under exceptional circumstances and to the satisfaction of the Principal, is eligible to appear for the additional examination.



- The Professor in charge of each forum will verify the students' claims for numbers of hours
- At the end of three years depending on the students' contribution towards ECA, TWO or FOUR credits will be awarded to the students.





ROSTRUM SPECTRUM

- Rostrum Spectrum aims at getting its participants debate and deliberate upon today's loose ended issues to carve out a blissful way ahead into the future.










